## **ROMA'S ROOM**

Access to Roma's Room is from the foyer and down one floor via stairs or lift to the lower ground floor.

**Seating** is set in rows with a central aisle holding a total capacity of 40. The audience enters from the back of the space, where there is room for a merchandise table if required.

**The stage** is set out facing the audience entrance. Dimensions: 3.8m x 2m (WxD)

Hire of Roma's Room includes the use of The **Cupboard** as dressing and/or wing space. **Dressing** 

Room 4 can be booked at an additional cost of £25.00+VAT (subject to availability, should you need more space).



**Lighting** is included in the form of the standard rig, which may be refocused as necessary but must be returned by the end of the night.

The rig consists of:

- 2 x Open white front lights
- 4 x LED side lights
- 1 x Centre spot

**Sound** is included in the form of our House PA, consisting of:

- Soundcraft Notepad 102 mixing desk located at rear of audience seating.
- 10 XLR & stereo jack inputs
- Main LR output
- 2 x speakers mounted either side of the stage
- 1 x Vocal mic
- 1 x Mic stand
- CD Player
- Mini-jack connection

Limited additional stock of XLR cable can be provided (subject to availability).

#### **Staff** included are:

- Technician on hand who can assist with setting up sound and lighting. We advise that you provide your own operators to monitor during the performance
- Front of House staff as appropriate to look after your audience (shared across all venues in performance)

We can supply an operator at additional cost, subject to availability and providing sufficient notice is given.

### **LOWRIE BAR**

Access to the Lowrie Bar is from the foyer and up one floor via stairs or lift to the first floor.

**Seating** is arranged in cabaret style as standard with total seated and standing capacity of 70.

The stage is elevated, one step up from the main floor, set against the window wall with blinds in place to mask the windows. Dimensions: 3.8m x 0.18m x 2m (WxHxD)

Hire of the Lowrie Bar includes the use of the **Cumberland Room** as a dressing/band room.

**Lighting** is included in the form of the standard rig, which may be altered as necessary and must be returned by the end of the night.

# The rig consists of:

- 2 x Open white front lights
- 2 x Purple back lights
- 1x Centre spot



**Sound** is included in the form of our house PA, consisting of:

- Soundcraft 328XD mixing desk located at rear of bar
- 16 XLR & stereo jack inputs
- Main LR output and 2 aux output
- 2 x speakers rigged each side of the stage overhead
- 2 x powered monitor speakers available for foldback
- 5 x Vocal mics
- 3 x Instrument mics
- 5 x Mic stands
- CD Player
- Mini-jack connection



### **Staff** included are:

- Technician on hand who can assist with setting up sound and lighting. We advise that you provide your own operators to monitor during the performance
- Front of House staff as appropriate to look after your audience (shared across all venues in performance)

We can supply an operator at additional cost, subject to availability and providing sufficient notice is given.

- Payment of a deposit and return of a signed contract is required in advance in order to secure any hire arrangement. Without these bookings may be cancelled without notice.
- The deposit is 100% of the hire cost. It is strictly non-refundable and non-transferable.
- The Crescent Theatre is a charity which does not rely on any external funding and as a result of this, prices quoted are non-negotiable and no further discounts will be applied to any booking.
- We do not take provisional bookings or pencil in dates. If you wish to secure your dates you must fill out an online booking form.

### **Box Office & Ticket Sales**

We sell your tickets for you through our own dedicated Box Office to customers in person, over the phone and online through our website. Our counter and phone lines are open Monday to Saturday, and on Sundays as required for performances.

You set the ticket price up to the maximum values stated above. We make no charge to you for tickets sold through our Box Office, we just add a commission (payable by the booker) to your ticket price to cover card transaction fees and the ticketing system.

The Box Office team manages all ticket orders placed through our website/phone/counter, and your audience will be able to receive their tickets by email, post or collect them from the Box Office. You can keep up to date and will receive weekly updates of your ticket sales.

Complimentary/Guest List tickets can be printed at a cost of 15p plus VAT per ticket.

#### Marketing

We have a number of channels through which we can help you to market your event:

- Posters, flyers and digital artwork displayed around the theatre
- Inclusion in our season brochure (dependent on deadlines)

# The Music Licence (PRSPPL)

An appropriate PRS form needs to be completed for every production. The appropriate rate will be applied to the final invoice.

### Front of House Information

The bar will be open to the audience before your show, serving a range of alcoholic drinks, soft drinks, hot drinks, sweets, snacks and ice creams. A steward will be provided for your show and can be available to sell programmes and merchandise on your behalf, for a commission of 15%. An information or merchandise table can be provided.
